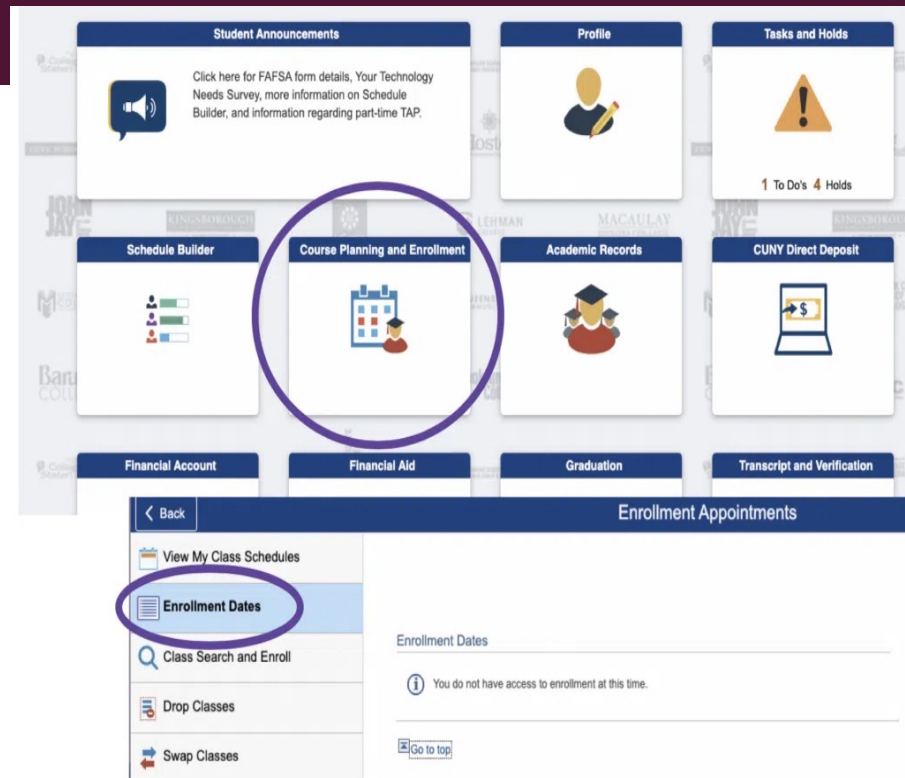

# ENROLLMENT APPOINTMENT (DAY AND TIME)

- After you have logged into your CUNYFirst account, click on the Student Center Tile.
- On the following screen click on the Course Planning and Enrollment Tile.
- Click on Enrollment Dates and Select the Term.

## CLEARING REGISTRATION HOLDS

- Check CUNYfirst > Student Center > Tasks and Holds
  - **Macaulay:** all MHC First, Second and Third year students will have an MHE hold, preventing courses from being added or dropped. This will be *cleared* once you have met with your advisor: Navdip Hans or Ben Ross.
- File FAFSA and TAP, and complete any Tasks (CUNYfirst > Student Center > Tasks and Holds), especially those related to financial aid.
- Bursar holds (BUR, BIH, others) are due to unpaid tuition/fees. Pay or resolve to be able to register.

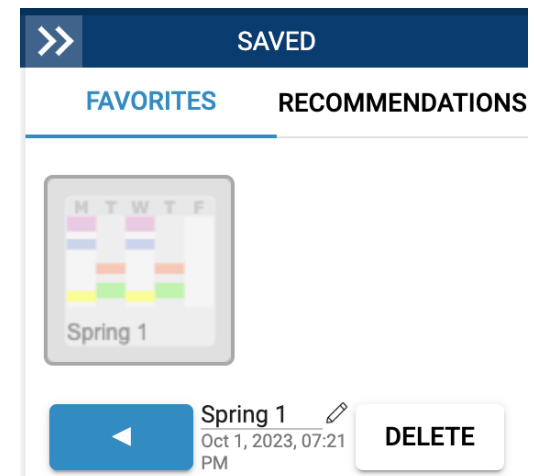

# SCHEDULE BUILDER: FINALIZE YOUR SCHEDULE

- When your **enrollment appointment** date and time has come, open Schedule Builder and display your preferred schedule

- On the next screen, check that your classes are correct, and the Action column shows **Enroll** for all classes
  - If you change your schedule after enrolling, you may also see **Drop, Swap, or None** in this column
- Click **Do Actions**
- **You should be enrolled!** Check the **Result** column to confirm
- If Result displays an Error, read the description for how to resolve it, or ask your **advisor**
- **Macaulay:** Your tuition scholarship covers **8 credits** of Summer classes, and **4 credits** of Winter classes. The student must cover the cost of additional credits beyond those limits.

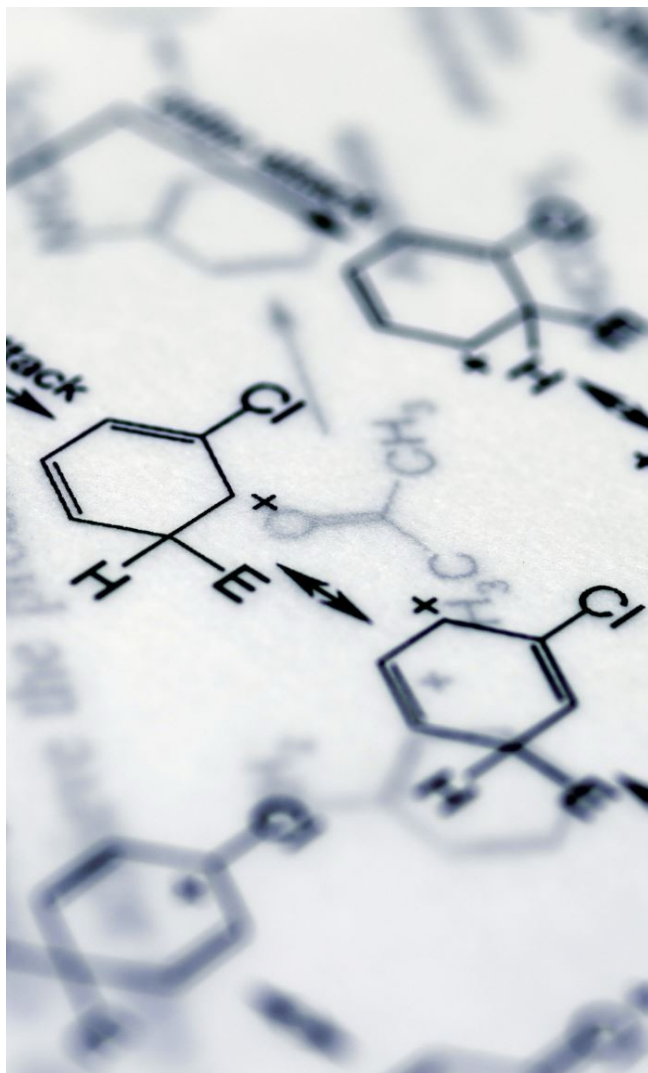

You may not get your first or even second choice of Seminar section. Save at least 3 alternate schedules on Schedule Builder to ensure you will have a Spring schedule that works.



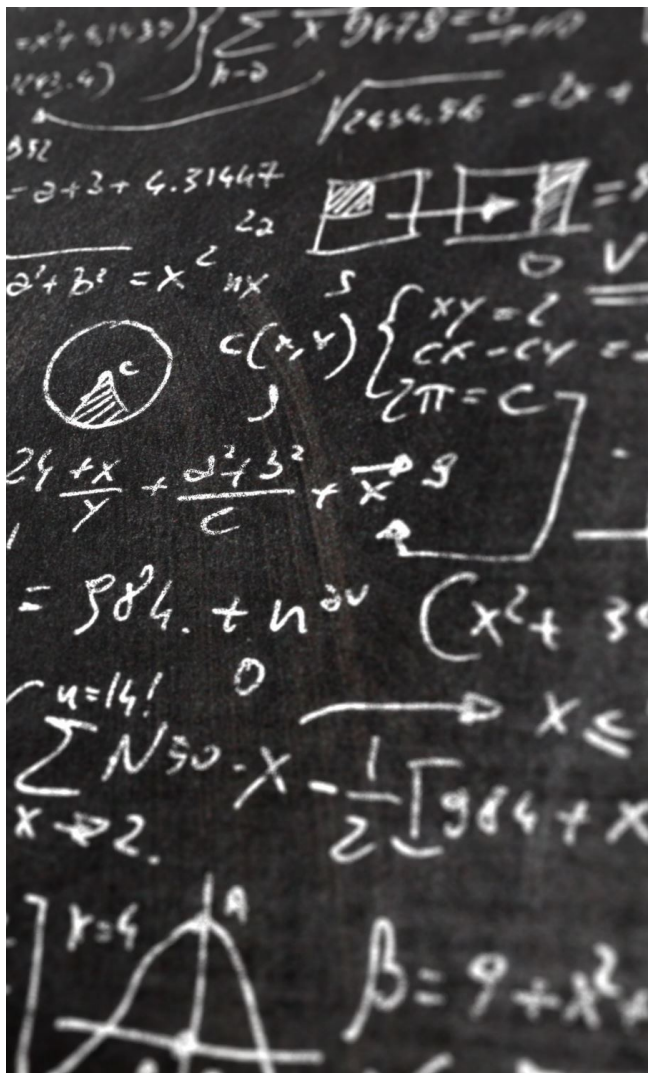
## SPECIAL REGISTRATION: CHEMISTRY

- The Chemistry Department will register students early for a limited number of reserved seats in their courses

## SPECIAL REGISTRATION: PSYCHOLOGY

- Seats in Psychology will be opened gradually, as few as 5 seats/per day. If your desired section fills quickly, don't worry, try again tomorrow.
- Most 200+ level Psych courses are only open to students who have declared the Psychology major or minor, or Neuroscience major
- PSYCH 213W registration is restricted to those with 60+ credits
- Courses between PSYCH 311-321: Restricted to those with 90+ credits, with limited seats, and limited to one course in this range per student.
